### Sewing Ladies of Del Rio Senior Center

We would like to share a letter the sewing ladies got from a soldier and how it touched their hearts.

"My name is Tara Schneider Alston and I was in the US Army (Medically Retired in 2013). In October of 2009 while stationed in Germany, I deployed to Afghanistan for 1 year. This was my first and only deployment. My husband was also in the same unit as I was so we deployed together. We were not married when we deployed and actually got married during our R & R (Rest and Relaxation). We spent those two weeks in Texas with both our families to get married. We then went back to Afghanistan to finish out the last 6 months of our deployment.

My husband and I used to love going to the Chaplin's office because he always had items (from hygiene to candy to socks and blankets) for soldiers. 

### Sausage Cake

- 1 pound Ground pork sausage 1 1/2 cups packed brown sugar
- 1 1/2 cups white sugar
- 2 eggs, beaten
- 3 cups sifted all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon ground ginger
- 1 teaspoon pumpkin pie spice
- 1 cup cold, strong, brewed coffee
- 1 cup raisins
- 1 cup chopped walnuts

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C) grease and flour a 9 inch Bundt pan. Pour boiling water over raisins and let stand 5 minutes. Drain well and dry raisins with a cloth towel.

- 1. In large bowl, combine sausage, brown sugar and white sugar. Stir until mixture is well blended. Add eggs and beat well.
- 2. In a separate bowl, sift together flour, ginger, baking powder and pumpkin pie spice.
- 3. Stir baking soda into coffee.
- 4. Add flour mixture and coffee alternately to sausage mixture, beating well after each addition. Fold raisins and walnuts into cake batter.

Pour batter into greased and floured 9 inch Bundt pan. Bake at 350 degrees F (175 degrees C) for 11/2 hours or until toothpick inserted into cake comes out clean. Cool in pan 15 minutes, then turn out onto wire rack.
