

What is a Makerspace?

Some of the items that will be available for public use are.







<u>Mastery: The Keys to Success and Long-term Fulfillment</u> by George Leonard draws on Zen philosophy and his expertise in the martial art of aikido. He shows how the process of mastery can help us attain a higher level of excellence and a deeper sense of satisfaction and fulfillment in our daily lives.

<u>Apache Legends & Lore of Southern New Mexico: From the Sacred Mountain</u> by Lynda A. Sanchez. Storytelling has been a vital and vivid tradition in Apache life. Coyote tales, the creation legend and stories of historic battles with Comanche and Anglo intruders create a colorful mosaic of tribal heritage. Percy Bigmouth, a prominent oral historian of the Mescalero and Lipan Apache tribes, realized in the early twentieth century that the old ways were waning. He wrote in longhand what he had learned from his father, Scout Bigmouth, a prison camp survivor at Fort Sumner and participant in the turbulent Apache wars. Join author Lynda Sanchez as she brings to light the ancient legends and lore of the Apaches living in the shadow of Mescalero's Sacred Mountain. Seventy-five years in the making, this collection is a loving tribute to a way of life nearly lost to history. <u>Conspiracy of Fools: A True Story</u> by Kurt Eichenwald. In a study of the Enron scandal, the author goes behind the scenes to profile the players and expose business practices involved in the financial and political debacle that ha d profound impact on both Washington and Wall Street.




crooner could have this much fun together.
